This month the Play Lab has playful exhibits that give you a chance to be a farmer. Plant and harvest carrots in our field, check the chicken coop for eggs, and sell produce at the Farm Stand. Perhaps challenge your class to create a structure or flower with the Engineering Station's slap bracelets and clothespins. Kids heading off to Kindergarten might want to practice packing up a lunch, buttoning up their clothes and tying their shoes, or even "writing" words on the felt board in the Construction Zone.

Maybe once he's got leaves, he will need flowers, fruit, acorns or even a few insects and pollinators buzzing around! Paper supplies, scissors, and tape can be found on the table right next to the tree. Feel free to incorporate any other process art supplies needed!
